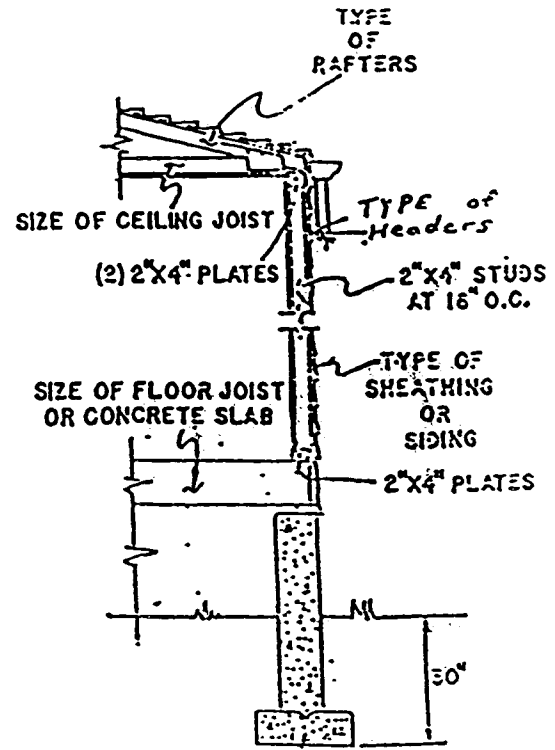
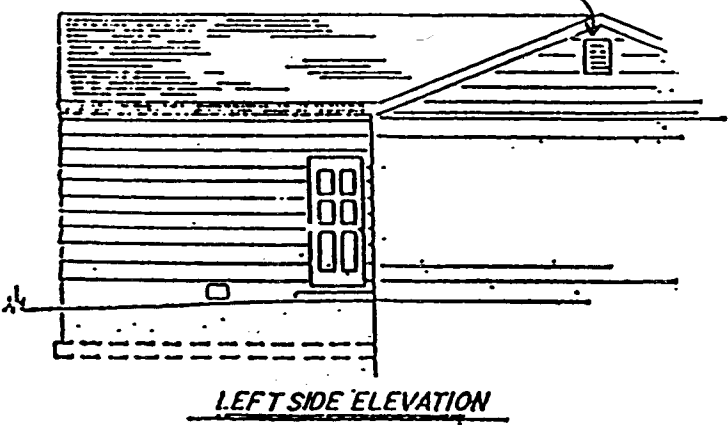

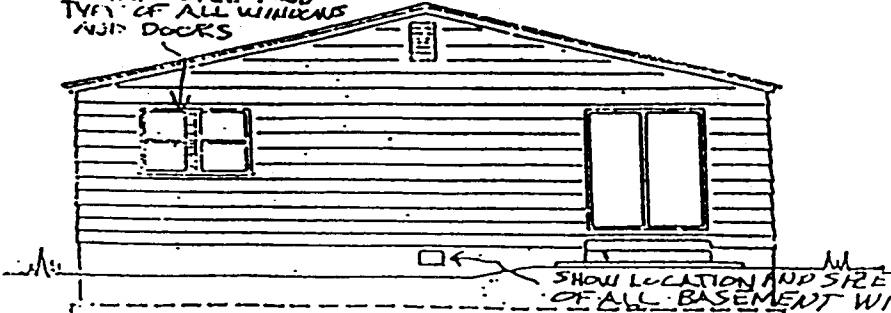

TYPICAL WALL SECTION

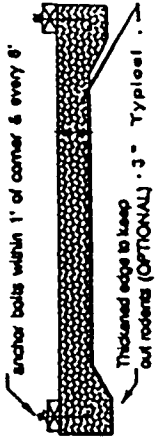

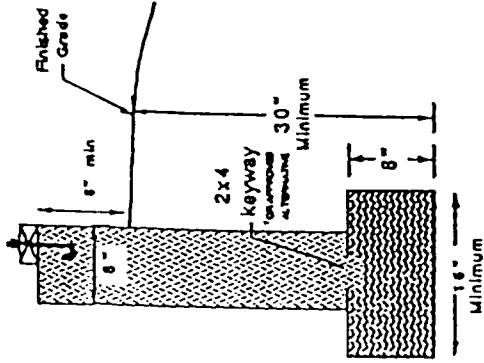

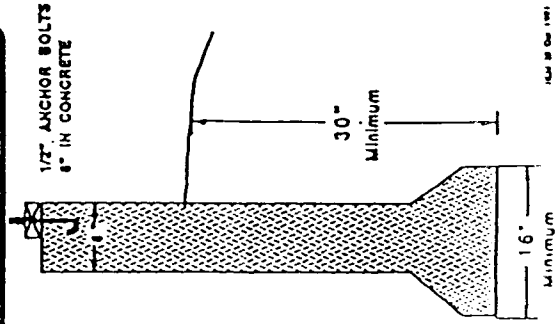
Slab on Grade for Small Sheds



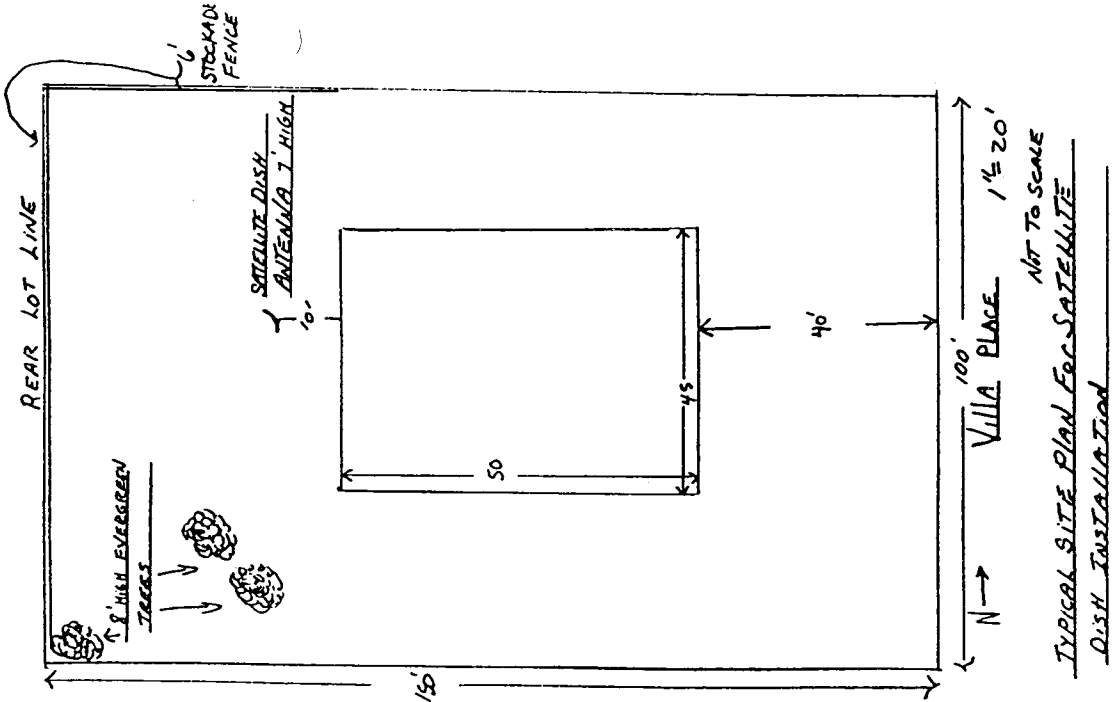
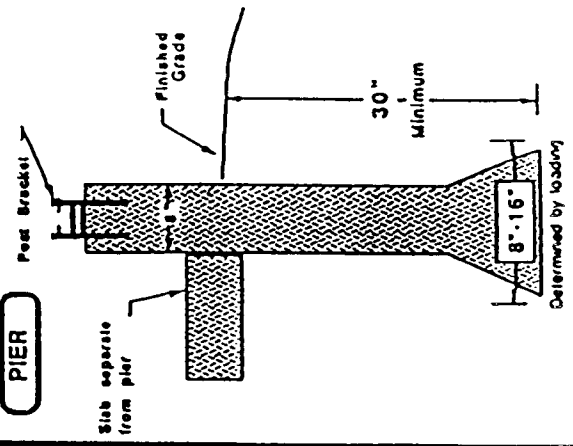
