Entry Deadline: All entry forms must be completed and submitted with artwork no later than 5:00pm Wednesday, April 7, 2010.

Eligibility: Open to all students in grades Kindergarten through 12th enrolled in a public, private, or parochial school in St. Louis city and county.

Elementary School level:

Division 1 - Kindergarten through 2nd

Division 2 - 3rd through 5th

Middle School level:

6th through 8th

High School level:

9th through 12th

Art Categories: Artwork will be accepted in up to four different categories, which include: Painting, Experimental, Works on Paper, and 3-Dimensional (High School ONLY). Participants are limited to three (3) entries per category in Elementary and Middle School. Participants are limited to two (2) entries per category in High School.

All artwork MUST contain a 3 x 5 inch card attached to the front of the artwork, or attached by string to 3-dimensional works. **The card MUST include the following information listed in the box to your left and the Artwork list price or NFS if the piece is NOT FOR SALE. If this information is unclear your piece will not be eligible.**

Artwork:

All artwork submitted must be original and executed solely by the competing artist. DO NOT submit work copies from published photos, books, posters, album covers, etc. or work done for the child by a parent or anyone else. All artwork must be mat mounted. Children may "mat" the artwork in a construction paper frame (or similar medium) if desired.

Liability Waiver:

Neither the City of Olivette nor the Olivette Community and Cultural Events Commission are responsible for the loss of or damage to artwork. All entries are subject to this condition.

No entries will be accepted after this time.

Pick-up: **Entries must be picked up by Friday, April 16, 2010 by 5pm or the entries will be disposed of due to lack of storage space.** Winning entries will be displayed at the awards ceremony and can be picked up at the conclusion of the awards ceremony.

Judging: Panel of highly qualified judges will judge all artwork.
