

Olivette City Council
Worksession Minutes
February 5, 2019

The Olivette City Council met on February 5 at 7:00pm in the Council Chambers at Olivette City Center located at 1140 Dielman Road, Olivette, Missouri. Mayor Weil called the meeting to order at 7:07 pm.

Item #1 – Roll Call

Item #2 – Update on Summer Camp Programs

Beverly Tucker-Knight updated the Council on the Olivette summer camp. The camp is being revamped and called Camp O. It will continue to offer the same day trip opportunities but will reduce the camper to staff ratio. Tucker-Knight informed the Council that the price of camp will be increasing and that notification to the prior campers will be sent out this week. Registration will be online beginning February 11.

Item #3 Discussion of Better Together Report

Sondag presented a report on the recently released Better Together report that calls for a constitutional amendment vote in November 2020. Sondag reviewed the written summary report as well as the 20-page proposed amendment.
