



JH Berra completed the last sewer segment from Olivette Crossing to Olive Blvd at Hilltop..

Unnerstall Contracting construction is currently working along Bon Price Lane and expect to have that section complete by the end of February. The new storm sewer segment under the channel has been installed. A second tunnel will be bore west across Price Road once work on Bon Price Lane is completed.

Kelpe Contracting has substantially completed all sewer pipe and associated structure work related to the Cherry Tree Lane storm water improvement project. They will remobilize to begin structural punch list items and restoration as soon as weather allows.

Public Works staff worked extracting road salt from the mines located at 1191 N Price Road. Staff mobilized for 48 continuous hours spending two nights at the PW building. The event was very demanding, and we are fortunate to have conscientious City operators. Had COVID 19 impacted any PW staff the outcome would have been very different!



Operators have to routinely clean the salt spreader hopper grates by climbing on top of the trucks. This is a very difficult task at night and even more so considering the extreme temperatures this past week.



The very light dry snow was drawn into the engine filters and froze. Operators had to frequently clean snow and ice out of the air intake tubes, thaw filter housings and swap in dry filters. Trucks do have shields and diverters over intakes to mitigate and this still occurs.
