The Budget year FY20 the fire department has purchased a new Rescue Air Bag system. The Rescue Air Bag system we currently have will no longer be of use to the City of Olivette Fire Department. We would like to donate our current Rescue Air Bag system to Eastern Douglas County Fire Department, Eastern Douglas County Volunteer Fire Department operates on a \$10,000 a year budget, and the department does not currently have an Air Bag System in their supply of equipment. Eastern Douglas County Fire Department covers over 200 square miles in rural southern Missouri. The department is operated by families volunteering in the community, the department does a great service for their neighbors. Air Bag Rescue system would be a great benefit to the department. I spoke with Chief Chris Hammett from Eastern Douglas County Fire Department and the department will sign a release of liability if the Air bag system is approved for donation.

We are making a request to approve a donation of the current Rescue Air Bag system to Eastern Douglas County Fire Department.
