New Council Members are sworn in, motions are made regarding appointment of a new Mayor and Chairman Pro-tem, and the City Council appoints the City Treasurer. In addition, appointment of Council Liaisons for the various Boards and Commissions are made, and the Council designates the official paper for publication.

Reorganization Memo

A. Certification of the April 6, 2021 Election Results from the St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners

The Mayor will ask the City Clerk to read the certified election results for the April 6, 2021 election. Per Section 6.4 of the City Charter, the Council shall declare those candidates receiving the highest number of votes, for the number of positions to be filled, to be elected.

Motion to accept the Certification of the April 6, 2021 election results from the St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners.

B. Swearing in of Elected Officials

The Mayor will ask the City Clerk to swear in the elected City Council Member. The Council Member will then take their seats.

C. Election & Swearing in of Mayor for 2021-2022

Section 2.3 of the City Charter calls for the City Council, at the time it reorganizes, to elect one of its members as Mayor for a period of one year. Nomination and vote will be held. The new Mayor will be sworn in for 2021-2022.

Nominations will be taken. No second is required. Council will vote on each nomination in the order each was nominated. The nominee with the most votes will be appointed Mayor.

Following the appointment, the Mayor will be sworn into office.

D. Election & Swearing in of Chairman Pro-Tem for 202021-2022

Section 2.3 of the City Charter calls for the Council, at the time it organizes, to elect one of its members as Chairman Pro-Tem for a period of one year. Nomination and vote will be held. The Chairman Pro-Tem will be sworn in for 2021-2022.

Nominations will be taken. No second is required. Council will vote on each nomination in the order each was nominated. The nominee with the most votes will be appointed Chairman Pro-Tem.

Following the appointment, the Chairman Pro-Tem will be sworn into office.

E. Recognition of Outgoing Mayor

Recognition of Mayor Springer by newly appointed Mayor.

F. Election of City Treasurer

The City Council will appoint the City Treasurer for the City of Olivette, pursuant to Section 4.4 of the Olivette City Charter. (Mike Ferguson currently serves as City Treasurer.)

Motion to appoint Mike Ferguson as the City Treasurer for 2021-2022 term.

G. Council Liaison Appointments

Council members will select the boards and/or commissions on which they would like to serve as Liaison. (The City Council may choose to wait until a future meeting for final selections.)
