

**Olivette City Council
Worksession Minutes
March 5, 2019**

The Olivette City Council met on March 5 at 7:00 in the Council Chambers at the Olivette City Center located at 1140 Dielman Road, Olivette, Missouri. Mayor Weil called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm.

Item #1 – Roll Call

On roll call, the following persons were present: Mayor Weil, Chairman ProTem Waldman, Councilmember Clark, Councilmember Springer and Councilmember Greg Carl.

Also in attendance: Barb Sondag City Manager.

Item #2 – Discussion of Park and Recreation Commission Work Plan

Council discussed the work plan as presented. The discussion was widened to the implementation on the Parks Master Plan and the draft scheduled recently developed by Navigate building Solutions. Council discussed the role of the Commission in the Community Center feasibility study. The Council reviewed the schedule and agreed that at the next regular meeting a draft contract with Ballard*King would be reviewed. In addition, the Council discussed the possibility of a bond vote in April of 2020.

Item #3 – Discussion of Medical Marijuana

All councilmembers attended the Municipal League of Metro St Louis meeting on February 28 and heard a panel discussion regarding medical marijuana. There was agreement that the Planning Commission should proceed with discussion or necessary ordinance amendments to incorporate medical marijuana dispensaries into Olivette zoning. The Council is hoping PCDC will forward any necessary changes for an April meeting.

Item #4 – City Manager's Report

The City Manager discussed with the Council the hiring process for a new Olivette Police Chief. The Council scheduled a retreat for April 1 at 5:30pm. The Council discussed the meeting order for the Town Hall meetings concerning Better Together. The Council discussed the Commission/Board members whose terms were expiring.
