

**City of Olivette  
City Council Worksession Minutes  
September 3, 2019**

The Olivette City Council met on September 3, at 7:00pm in the Council Chambers at the Olivette City Center located at 1140 Dielman Road, Olivette, Missouri. Mayor Waldman called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

**Item #1 – Roll Call**

On roll call, the following persons were present: Mayor Waldman, Chairman ProTem Springer, Councilmember Greg Carl, C and Councilmember Clark.

Also in attendance: Barb Sondag City Manager and Beverly Tucker-Knight Parks and Recreation Director. Jim Person, Kisha Lee, and Ed Kastner Park & Recreation Commissioners.

**Item #2 – Discussion of Chapter 220 Nuisances - Continued**

Chuck Caverly (Botanist & Arborist with Native Landscape Solutions and Councilmember at Maryland Heights) gave a presentation on invasive species. Caverly addressed the definition of invasives, identified common invasives seen in the region, and explained the difficulty in removing invasives. Caverly then discussed the ordinance passed by Maryland Heights and how that city was implementing the ordinance. Specifically, Maryland Height has undertaken a communication campaign to alert people to the dangers of invasives and how to remove them.

The Council will continue the discussion at a future meeting.

**Item # 3 Discussion of Wayfinding**

Jim Reddington and Amy Knopf with Kiku Obata presented options for wayfinding design. The Council discussed the options and associated cost. The Council requested that the firm investigate utilizing the sign shape from Concept A with the poles of Concept B. Current consensus was for the signs to be green, but Council did request that the next mock-up show both green and blue.
