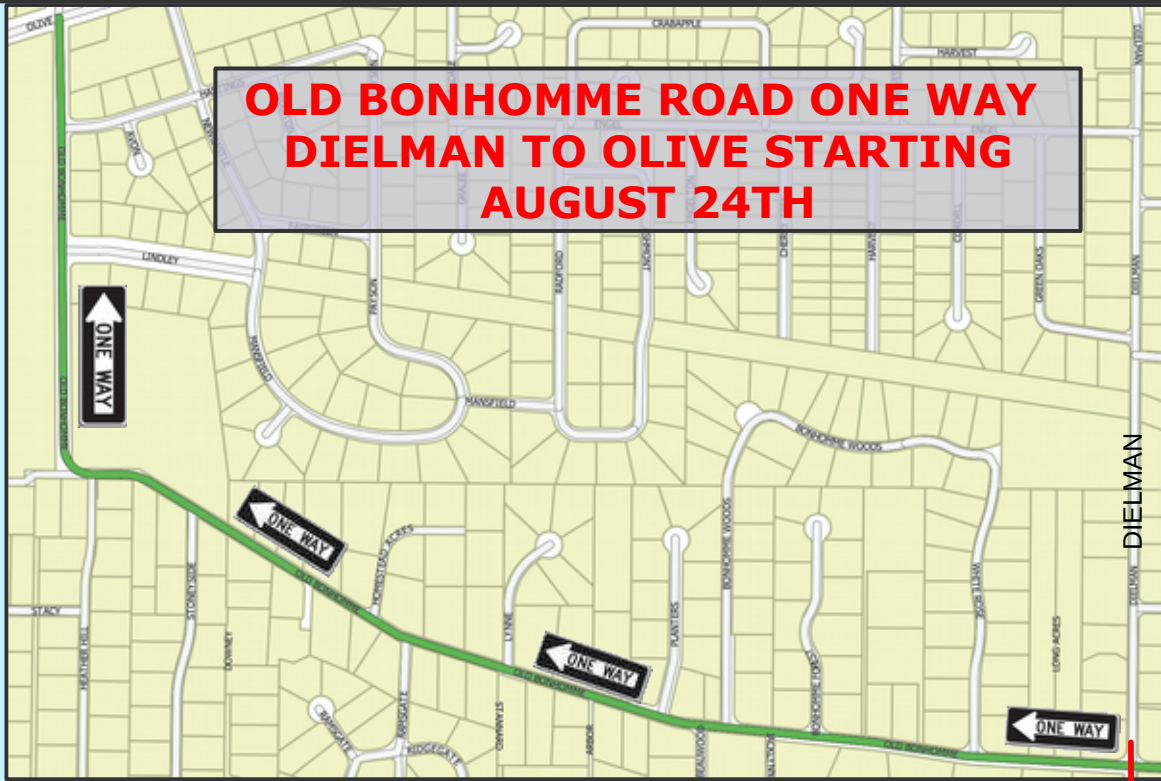


# Old Bonhomme Road Restoration Project

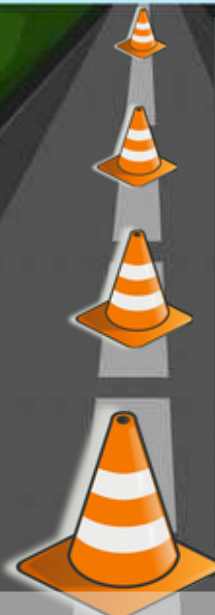


**OLD BONHOMME ROAD ONE WAY  
DIELMAN TO OLIVE STARTING  
AUGUST 24TH**

THE EAST BOUND LANE BETWEEN DIELMAN AND OLIVE WILL BE CLOSED ON AUGUST 24<sup>TH</sup>. TRAFFIC FLOW WILL BE ONE WAY WEST BOUND FROM DIELMAN TO OLIVE. CONSTRUCTION CREWS WILL BEGIN ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF OLD BONHOMME AT DIELMAN WORKING WEST.

SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION ALONG STACY PARK WILL CONTINUE ONCE AT&T AND AMEREN UE COMPLETE UNDERGROUND CABLE RELOCATIONS.

## Sidewalk Passing Zones

The Public Right of Way's Access Guide requires 5ft x 5ft passing zones to accommodate mobility impaired persons using the sidewalks. The passing zones allow everyone to share the public space along Old Bonhomme Road. If you see someone that needs extra space take advantage of the passing zone.

## Welcome Back to School

The Ladue School District is working to optimize bus routes. Please be patient and proceed with caution through the construction zones.

## Mowing

Please mow the area between the curb and sidewalk. Grass seed has a percentage of weeds to promote germination that will emerge before grass. The landscaping contractor will be going back through the project to reestablish soil and seed that has eroded with the recent storms.

## Construction Zone Safety

- Drive slowly and cautiously
- Remain calm. Construction crews will accommodate you as efficiently as possible. In active working areas, wait for a signal before proceeding
- Keep children away from equipment and materials. It is difficult for workers to see children, and there are many potential hazards.
- Children and parents are welcome to watch from a safe distance.
- Cyclists should watch for construction vehicles in the work zone and ride or walk their bike on the grass when a vehicle is in the vicinity

## Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste

Present your collection materials at the curb just like normal. Construction Crews will allow Republic Services trucks into the construction zone.

## Property Owner Utilities

Property owners should inventory any sprinkler, dog fence or landscape lighting that is near the project limits and make arrangements to have items marked or moved. Contact the project liaison if you have any questions.

## Sidewalk Vegetation Obstructions

Recent rainfall has given shrubbery and trees the opportunity to flourish. By ordinance residents are required to trim back growth that encroaches the sidewalk path. Please do your part so we can all enjoy the new sidewalks!

## Milling and Paving

Milling, the process of removing the top layer of asphalt, is scheduled to begin mid September. This process involves a high concentration of equipment and trucks. Traffic congestion is expected between Price and Dielman. Please plan accordingly.

Paving is the process of placing hot asphalt in the milled area followed by mechanical compaction.

This process is scheduled to begin mid September between Price and Dielman and Lynne and Olive. It is anticipated that milling and paving will take 6 working days to complete in each section (Price to Dielman and Lynne to Olive).
