## **City Center RFP** (Old City Hall Site)

As with the Gateway development, proposals will not be made public until later as the Council may be in negotiations with the developers.

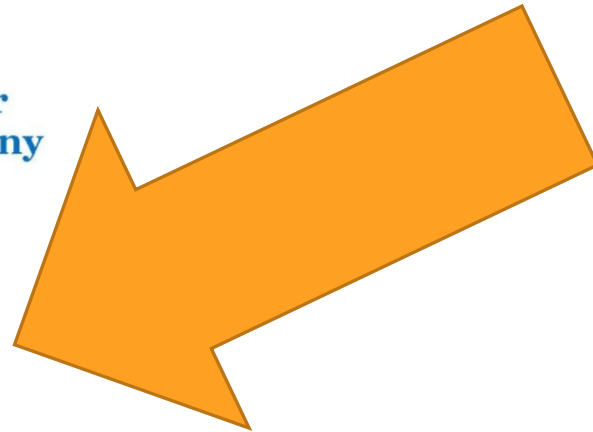
