Work Around the City

Carlos Trejo was successful in the department's application to present at the **2017 Missouri American Planning Association** conference to be held in St. Louis during October.

Title: "Developing A Catalyst Strategy"

Presentation Summary: *Quality of place can have a profound impact on local markets and economies. Understanding the market is essential to developing a sustainable strategy. Developing a comprehensive Planning Process and engaging community leaders with realistic expectations is essential to determine the feasibility of making plans happen. This session provides an overview of the city of Olivette's efforts to develop a catalyst strategy for the redevelopment along the Olive Boulevard corridor.*

Work Around the City

City Clerk **Myra Bennett** was selected to fill a one-year term as one of the Directors of the **Eastern Division of the Missouri City Clerks and Finance Officers Association.**

Other Updates

City Center RFP (Old City Hall Site)

The City received one response to the RFP. The respondent was Sansone Group with Douglas Properties. The proposal is being reviewed by Development Strategies and Economic Development Commission will discuss the proposal and review at their August 21 meeting.



Gateway Redevelopment (I-170 and Olive)

Transportation plan has been submitted to MODoT. Grading and Utility plans are near completion. Purchase of properties is complete. Discussions with prospective tenants continues.

St Louis Water

City of St Louis Water Division is performing work at the Dielman Road along the stream bank.

Routine inspections noted an exposed water conduit. St. Louis will be encasing the exposed section and then rebuilding the bank.
