

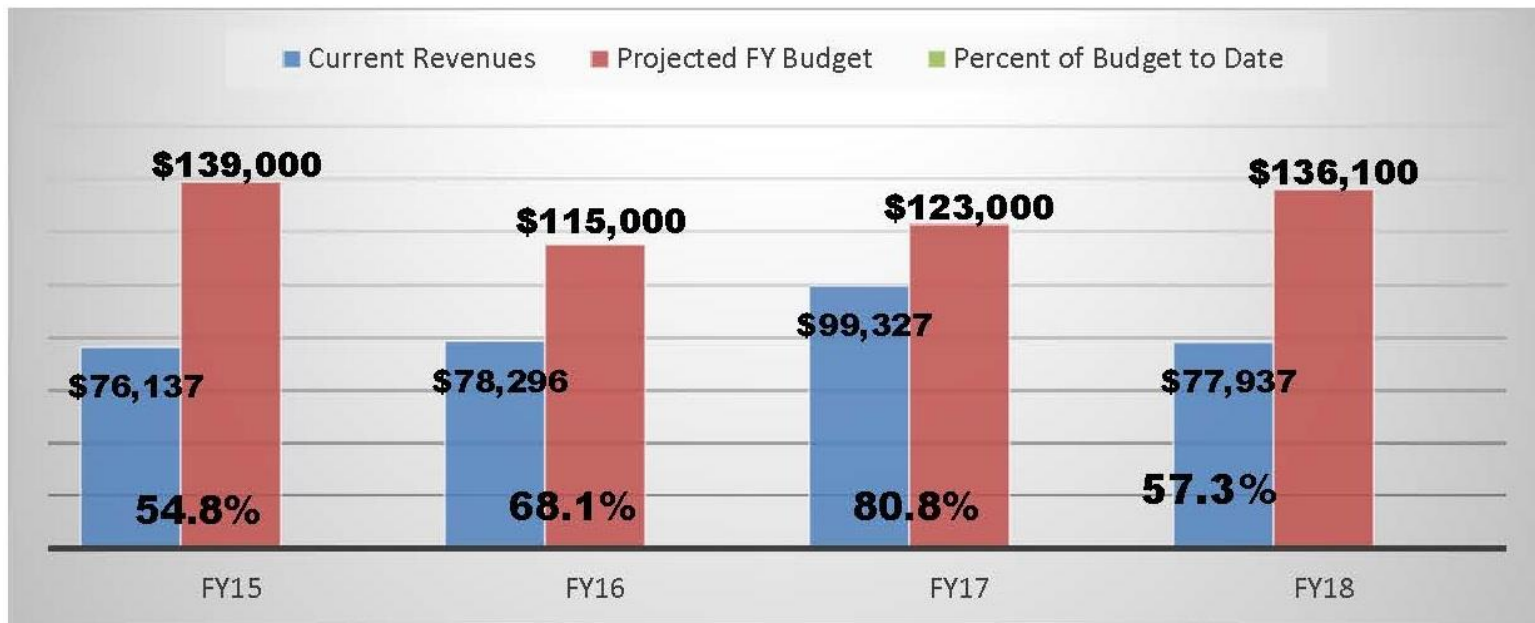

Department Updates

Water main work along Price Road is about 30% complete. Missouri American Water will be paving the areas that have been disturbed by the replacement. But that work may not be until July.

Public Works staff poured its first concrete on April 9. They are working in the Friese and Bon Price Terrace area.

Street Sweeping began, with one pass collecting close to 50 cubic yards of debris



Department Updates

The Police Department continues to work toward CALEA accreditation. With most policies reviewed, the Department anticipates a “mock review” in the fall.

Judge John Paul Frisella is settling in as Olivette's Municipal Judge. Judge Frisella held court for the first time on April 11.

Regional Cooperation

East Central Dispatch Center's (ECDC) Executive Director Amy Williams resigned her position effective May 4. The ECDC Board has begun a search for a new director.

Next Generation 911 service was to have been implemented in the region well over two years ago. NG911 provides location information to dispatchers through the phone service. Essential information when someone is not sure where they are, OR is unable to speak. Staff would like to discuss this situation with Council later in the meeting.

St. Louis Area Insurance Trust (SLAIT) announced health insurance rates for the upcoming fiscal year.

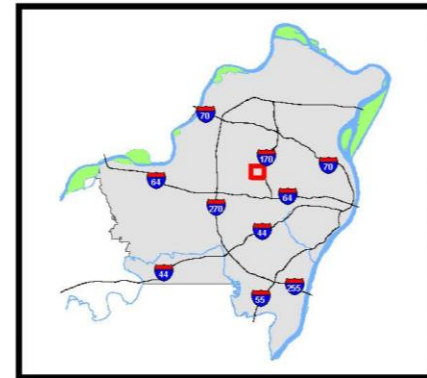
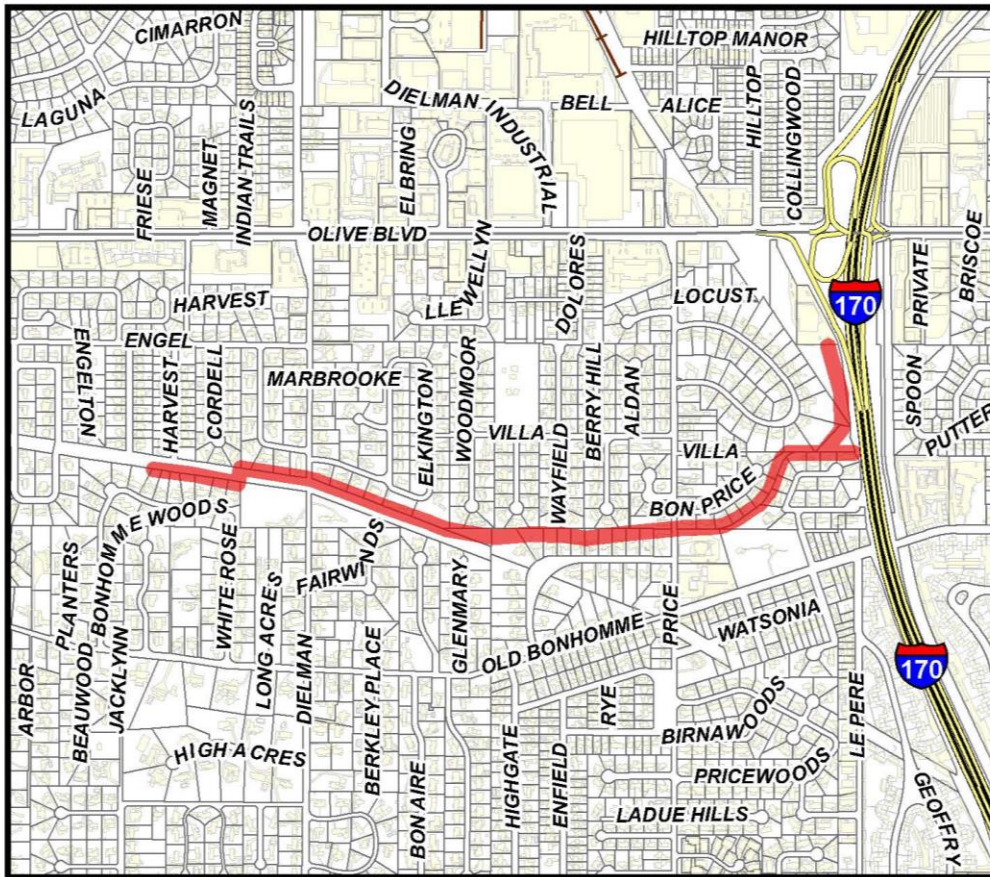
The City of Olivette will experience a 2% increase. SLAIT has continued to provide excellent coverage with lower than average annual increases.
