McGregor did an excellent job preparing for the audit and everyone left impressed with work being done here in Olivette.

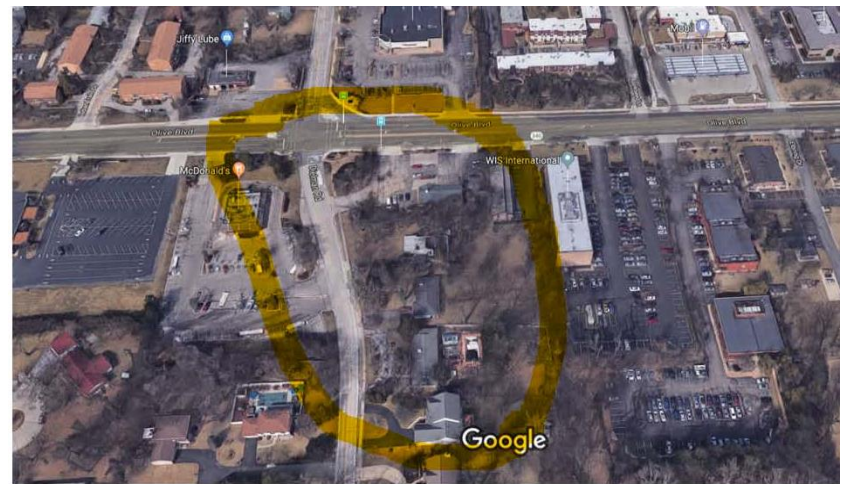


Other Business
