In addition, staff has been meeting with representatives of PACE Properties, Balke Brown Transwestern, and Payne Family Homes. The immediate goal is to showcase to these developers, the opportunities that exists in Olivette. The longer-term goal is to continue to implement the ideas contained within the Strategic Plan.


## **Work Around Town**

### Missouri American Water Company – Price Road Project

- Water main work on Price Road south of Olive is 100% complete.
- The boring under Olive is complete, but new pipes are not in service yet.
- MAWC did not receive any bids for the paving of Price Road. It is unclear at this time how MAWC will proceed with the paving.

PW Director Bruce McGregor has been attempting to stay on top of this process, but communication has been difficult.

Missouri American Water Company – Other Projects MAWC will soon begin additional smaller water main replacement projects.
