Request for Proposals

City Center Redevelopment Area – The City received two proposals and the Economic Development Commission began its review of the proposals at their meeting last night.

Dielman Road Improvements (Fairwinds to Tamarack) – The City received nine proposals. The low bidder was RV Wagner.

City Center Landscaping Maintenance – The City received one proposal for landscaping services at the City Center. The bid is being reviewed.

Community Center Kitchen

After a thorough cleaning, and repairs to the floor, exterior door and refrigerator, the Community Center kitchen has received an A rating permit from the County Health Dept for cold food preparation. (Lack of an ANSUL fire suppression system, commercial stove and non-permeable ceiling prevents the kitchen from being permitted for hot food preparation.)

Currently the City leases the kitchen to a caterer who prepares pre-packaged meals for afterschool programs, adult care centers and summer meal programs serving low income families.

Stacy Prairie Burn 2019

The City has received a burn permit from the County for the Stacy Park prairie valid through April 15, 2019. City Horticulturalist Heather Liszewski and volunteer Burn Boss Gerald Axelbaum work together to target specific time periods and then wait for favorable conditions that include: moisture content in the ground, wind speed and upper atmospheric conditions. The burn permit may expire without meeting all conditions and having adequate staff and volunteers on hand

Co-Sponsoring Events Trial

Park and Recreation Director Beverly Tucker-Knight is experimenting with the idea of the City co-sponsoring events in our parks. The City hosts several events over the year, but give human and financial resources expanding our community programming would need to be in cooperation with existing entities.
