## **Gateway Project**

All the properties involved in the Gateway Project have been purchased by the Developer Keat Properties.

The project is before the Planning and Community Design Commission for review. The next meeting of the PCDC is August 15 at 7pm.

## **City Center Redevelopment Project**

The City continues to work with Ridgehouse LLC on redevelopment of the old city hall site and the two parcels to the west. Work continues on the Redevelopment Plan document as well as the Benefit-Cost Analysis. It is anticipated the Redevelopment Plan will come before the Council in September.



# News from North Price

## **Dielman Road Project - Phase I**

- Construction on the Dielman Road Project will soon begin moving northward on the western side of Dielman. South of Old Bonhomme Road new sidewalks will be installed.
- It is anticipated that Dielman Road will need to be closed for a minimum of two days when replacement of a stormwater system near High Acres occurs. This work has been delayed due to the need to manufacture some of the stormwater infrastructure. It is anticipated the work will begin in the next week.

## **City Work**

Summer paving will continue on Oak Estates, Chantal, Heatherwood, and North Price.

Surface treatment will continue later this year on Green Oak, Napolean, and Marbrooke.

# News from the Region

## **St. Louis County Charter Review Commission**

The County Charter Review Commission is working to wrap-up their work in the next few months. The Commission, created by a vote of the people in 2018, has one year to review and propose changes to the County Charter. After months of working group meetings, the Commission will begin voting on proposed measures in the next few weeks.

They are planning public meetings at different locations within the County, but dates, times and locations have not been determined.

## **Board of Freeholders**

Early in 2019, in response to the Better Together constitutional amendment, the Municipal League of Metro St Louis began collecting signatures for the formation of a Board of Freeholders. The League has begun submitting petitions to the County and City for verification of signatures. Once the required number of signatures is attained the City Mayor and County Executive will begin the process of appointing people to serve on the Board.
