Development Updates

The Planning and Community Design Commission will take up rezoning and approvals for the construction set to occur at 9514 Olive (old Ponderosa) on February 20.

Demolition at the Gateway is scheduled to begin in the next weeks. The City is waiting on paperwork from the County.

Construction of a new Firestone at 9398 Olive is one step closer to becoming a reality as the modifications to the Special Permit currently on the property will be presented to the City Council on February 25.

Douglas Properties is moving forward with the construction of approximately 30 Townhomes located on Dielman Road across from the City Center.

In Other News



At a meeting with City staff, Keat Olivette Gateway, and Great Rivers Greenway, engineers discussed the Centennial Trail crossing at Hilltop. The meeting was very productive with engineers coming to agreements on several aspects of the crossing.

A meeting with Ladue School District Superintendent Dr. Jim Wipke was held last week. It was a very productive meeting, as we looked for areas in which we can increase our collaboration. Strong community and strong schools don't just happen, and it was pleasure to meet with Dr. Wipke and discuss our joint future.

The City anticipate receiving Right of Way clearance from MODoT in the near future. This approval will allow the City to seek bids for contractors for the construction of Dielman Road Project Phase II.

The City is now accepting proposals for the new Fire Pumper Truck. It is anticipated a recommendation will come before the Council in April. This new engine will replace one of the two 2005 engines currently in service.
