Coronavirus Disease 2019 (Covid-19)

The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.

The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person.

- Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
- Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.

Protect Yourself

- **Wash your hands** often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially after you have been in a public place, or after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- If soap and water are not readily available, **use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol**. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry.
- **Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth** with unwashed hands.

City Precautions

- More questions when you call dispatch (911)
- First Responders will wear protective gear if responding to a call with flu like symptoms
- More routine cleaning of door handles and other often touched surfaces
- Change in cleaning products
- Employees transacting business with the public may choose to wear gloves
- Ensure redundancy of key positions and business practices
- Sick leave encouraged for those who have symptoms
- Review of forthcoming scheduled time off to ensure staffing levels
- Discussion of process by which programs, events or meetings might be cancelled
- Discussion of live-streaming meetings
- Participation in soon to begin County Public Health media updates
- Participation in regional Emergency Operations Center meetings and protocol implementation
