North Price Road & Olive Boulevard Conceptual Study

The City has engaged Access Engineering for work concerning the intersection of North Price and Olive Blvd. The work will seek to improve access from southbound North Price onto Olive Boulevard.

Access Engineering will:

- Review available traffic studies
- Perform site inspections
- Prepare a concept plan
- Prepare construction cost estimates

The goal will be to inform and prepare the City for both future improvements and leverage funding sources.

A fresh look for the classic Olivette day camp. With home base inside the Community Center, this adventure day camp features three age-specific camp divisions. Each week's activities are structured around a theme and include music, sports, arts & crafts, creative dramatics, science play, cooking, and non-directed play. Fee includes all materials, daily snack, and camp t-shirt. Campers wear closed toe-shoes and bring a hat, water bottle, and sack lunch each day.
